## TOWN OF GREENVILLE ORDINANCE NO. 2021-WW-006

## ORDINANCE FOR ESTABLISHMENT OF SEWER UTILITY DEPOSIT FUND FOR GREENVILLE MUNICIPAL UTILITIES OF GREENVILLE, INDIANA.

WHEREAS: Indiana Code 36-4-6-18 permits the legislative body to pass ordinances, orders, resolutions, and motions for the government of the town, the control of the town's property and finances, and the appropriation of money; and

WHEREAS: Indiana Code 8-1.5-3-11 permits the legislative body to pass for the establishment of Utility Deposit Fund to separate customer funds from that of the utility.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GREENVILLE, INDANA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The Town Council hereby establishes a Sewer Account Deposit Fund for providing accessibility to customer sewer utility account deposits for refund upon closing of the account with no outstanding balances.

Section 2: The deposit amount shall be established and can be adjusted by Ordinance.

Section 3: All customer deposit funds shall be kept in a separate fund that will be under the control of the Town Clerk with access limited to that authority and supervised by the Town Council.
