**RESOLUTION CONCERNING THE APPROVAL FOR SALE OF AND PURCHASE OF FIREARMS AND
HOLSTERS FOR THE TOWN OF GREENVILLE, INDIANA MARSHAL DEPARTMENT**


WHEREAS, the Town Council for the Town of Greenville, Indiana, is interested in providing the Greenville Marshal Department with proper equipment to execute their duties and work with other law enforcement agencies;

WHEREAS, the Greenville Marshal often calls on Floyd County Sheriff's department for backup and at times will backup the Floyd County Sheriff department. The Greenville Town Council has approved Marshal Craig to sell the six (6) Glock 23 pistols to HiTek Firearms & Training and purchase two (3) Glock 21 Gen 4 pistols and two (2) holsters from Kiesler's Police Supply, Inc.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GREENVILLE, INDIANA, AS FOLLOWS:


1. Marshal Craig will sell Six (6) Glock 23 pistols plus magazines to HiTek Firearms & Training for Three Hundred US Dollars (\$300) each for a total selling price of One Thousand Eight Hundred US Dollars (\$1800).
2. Marshal Craig will sell the current Glock 23 holsters. The money will be deposited into the general account and marked for the use by the Marshal Department.
3. Marshal Craig will purchase two (3) Glock 21 Gen 4 pistols from Kiesler's Police Supply, Inc. for the amount of Four Hundred Sixty-Nine US Dollars (\$469.00) each.
4. Marshal Craig will purchase one (1) Safariland Fine Tac with Light Holster for Eight-Five US Dollars (\$85.00) and one (1) Safariland Fine Tac Holster for Seventy-Six US Dollars (\$76.00).
5. Marshal Craig will purchase six (6) boxes of Federal HS 45 ACP 230 GR ammunition for a total price of One Hundred Fifty Three US Dollars (\$153).
6. The total expense for the town is Zero US Dollars (\$0). The Marshal Department will receive seventy-nine US Dollars (\$79) to be used for future Marshal expenses.
