March 10, 1975

Terry Boaz opened the meeting. All members, Charles Birkla, James Harl, L.C. Asher, Chris Linton, and Farnsley Burkhart were present. The minutes from the last meeting were read and approved. Claims were presented and approved for payment. The treasurer report is as follows; Checking--\$8,637.94, General--\$1,577.60, Local \$697.50, Street--\$6,155.67, CCIF--\$207.17, Revenue Sharing--\$3,522.60.

Terry Boaz reported that Elbert Nash resigned as water superintendent as of March 10, 1975. Terry Boaz also stated that the board had contacted with L.C. Asher and Chris Linton to do the outside work of the water company and Janice Gibson to do the clerical work on an hourly basis. L.C. Asher was appointed principle official of the water company.

Robert Gibson brought a report from Louis Marlow, an engineer, that shows the load limit of the proposed bridge to be more than 20 ton. Gary Jacobi will resubmit application #2 for Local Road Monies.

James Harl reported that painting the police car would be \$40.00 for labor plus paint and new signs. The board tabled action because of no funds in the budget.

The board stated that the fluoride equipment is ready for use and that people had been notified that fluoride was to be placed in the water, but that the fluoridation has not be started. L.C. Asher said he would check into ordering the fluoride and placing it in the water supply.
