## Minutes of Greenville Town Council Meeting April 08<sup>th</sup>, 2013

Council President Talbotte Richardson called the regular monthly meeting to order. Other Councilpersons present were Bob Wright, Patti Hayes, Darryl Kepley, and Greg Redden, along with Clerk Jack Travillian. Also attending the meeting were Town Manager Randal Johnes, Marshal Bill Burkhart, Water Superintendent Gary Getrost and several concerned citizens. The meeting was opened with a prayer from Pastor Avery, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Ordinance 2013-WR-021: RESOLUTION CONCERNING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF S.O.P. 05/01/13 STANDARD OPERATION PROCEDURE FOR THE GREENVILLE MUNICIPAL WATER AND SEWER UTILITY OF THE TOWN OF GREENVILLE, INDIANA: Reading of the resolution was completed and the motion was made by President Richardson and seconded by Councilwoman Hayes. Motion passed 4-0-1. Council members voting for the resolutions were President Richardson, Councilman Redden, Councilman Wright and Councilwoman Hayes. Abstaining was Councilman Kepley.

Ordinance 2013-TR-023: RESOLUTION CONCERNING THE REDUCTION IN TOWN COUNCIL MEMBERSHIP: Reading of the resolution was completed. Councilman Redden is proposing this motion to reduce the cost of the town's general budget. There was a brief discussion, and the motion was made by Councilman Redden and seconded by Councilwoman Hayes. Motion passed 3-2. Council members voting for the resolutions were President Richardson, Councilman Redden, and Councilwoman Hayes. Council members voting against the resolution were Councilman Kepley and Councilman Wright.

The following Resolution was presented and explained by Council President Richardson prior to the reading and the vote by the council. This Resolution will set up a voting referendum for the voters of Greenville to decide by a vote to either reduce the number of Council Members from **5** to **3** or have the Council Membership to remain at 5. This Special Voting Referendum is required by Indiana State Statue I.C. 36-5-2-4.2 and I.C. 3-10-9-4.

Ordinance 2013-TR-024: RESOLUTION CONCERNING THE DECREASE IN TOWN COUNCIL MEMBERSHIP (Setting up Election): Reading of the resolution was completed and the motion was made by President Richardson and seconded by Councilwoman Hayes. Motion passed 3-2. Council members voting for the resolutions were President Richardson, Councilman Redden, and Councilwoman Hayes. Council members voting against the resolution were Councilman Kepley and Councilman Wright.

Councilwoman Hayes left the meeting due to a conflicting work schedule.

## Marshal Report:

Marshal Burkhart presented the council members with the monthly report. The marshal's department did complete an investigation that led to one arrest. The officers will be changing up hours of patrol.

Review/Approval Checks and Expenditures: Clerk Travillian presented the forms for the checks written from the utility and the town. The checks were approved without objections.

## **Committee Reports:**

**Town Manager:** Randal Johnes has posted his report on the town website along with emailing all council members and the clerk. No questions concerning the report.

## Water Utility Business:

Superintendent Getrost gave the monthly adjustment report. No questions were asked. Superintendent Getrost attended a meeting with Indiana Department of Transportation about the placing of a light and turn lane expansion for Highway 150 and Greenville/Georgetown Road. A bid has been accepted and construction will begin soon. The water utility will be required to move two (2) or three (3) water hydrants for the construction project.

Ordinance 2013-WO-018: ORDINANCE CONCERNING CANCELLATION OF WARRANTS – OLD OUTSTANDING CHECKS FOR THE GREENVILLE WATER UTILITY OF THE TOWN OF GREENVILLE, INDIANA: First reading of the ordinance was completed and the motion was made for unanimous consent by President Richardson and seconded by Councilman Redden. Motion passed 4-0. Second reading was completed. President Richardson made a motion to accept the ordinance and seconded by Councilman Redden. Motion passed 4-0. Third reading was completed. A motion was made by President Richardson and seconded by Councilman Redden to accept the ordinance. Motion passed 4-0.

## RESOLUTION CONCERNING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF S.O.P. 05-012013 STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURE FOR THE GREENVILLE MUNICIPAL WATER AND SEWER UTILITY OF THE TOWN OF GREENVILLE, INDIANA

WHEREAS, the Greenville Municipal Water and Sewer Utility Council for the Town of Greenville, Indiana, in the interest of compliance with I.C. 8-1.5-3-4 has deemed it necessary that the Greenville Municipal Water and Sewer Utility Council develop a resolution concerning Standard Operating Procedures for the Greenville Municipal Water and Sewer Utility and;

WHEREAS, the Greenville Municipal Water Utility has purchased the Heritage Springs WWTP and will take possession and take over operations on May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2013 and;

WHEREAS, it is necessary to develop a new S.O.P. to replace S.O.P. 01-14-08 validated by Town of Greenville Resolution 2009-R-025 because of the acquisition of the Heritage Springs WWTP by the Greenville Municipal Water Utility;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GREENVILLE MUNICIPAL WATER AND SEWER UTILITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GREENVILLE, INDIANA, AS FOLLOWS:

## STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURES – GREENVILLE MUNICIPAL WATER AND SEWER UTILITY S.O.P. 05-01-2013

## WATER UTILITY

- 1. These procedures replace procedures stated in S.O.P. 01-14-08 adopted by Town of Greenville Resolution 2009-R-025 dated May  $26^{th}$ , 2009.
- 2. Each month customers receive a billing that indicates their water consumption and charges for the previous month.
- 3. Payments are due on or before the 15<sup>th</sup> of the month, after the 15<sup>th</sup> of the month penalties are accrued.

## PROCEDURES FOR CUSTOMER'S DELINQUENT WATER ACCOUNTS ARE AS FOLLOWS:

1. If the account is not paid during the current billing cycle they shall receive another bill during the next billing cycle with the past due charges of 10% on the remaining balance with current charges added together.

- 2. If the amount is not paid on or before the 15<sup>th</sup> of the month, and they have a two month balance the customer receives a disconnect notice.
- 3. The disconnect notice provides the customer with the amount they owe and the date it must be paid to avoid being disconnected.
- 4. The customer at this point has the option to contact the Greenville Municipal Water and Sewer Utility, prior to the disconnect date, to make payment arrangements.
- 5. The two-month balance along with A \$50.00 reconnect fee must be paid in full to re-establish water service.
- 6. The Greenville Municipal Water and Sewer Utility requires a minimum of 24 hours to re-instate water service, on the same business day if they receive the payment during regular business hours, and the personnel to do so.
- 7. If a customer requests water service to be re-instated after regular business hours, the decision shall be made by the Greenville Municipal Water and Sewer Utility Superintendent or Assistant Greenville Municipal Water and Sewer Utility Superintendent if Superintendent is not available. A charge of \$50.00 will be added to accommodate overtime hours it would take to re-instate service.

## SEWER UTILITY

- 1. Each month customers receive a billing that indicates their charges for the month.
- 2. Payments are due on or before the 15th day of the month billed, after the 15th day of the month penalties are accrued.
- 3. Disconnection of Water Service for non-payment of Sewer billing is allowed under Indiana Code I.C. 8-1.5-3-4 {d}.

## PROCEDURES FOR CUSTOMER'S DELINQUENT SEWER ACCOUNTS ARE AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. If the account is not paid during the current billing cycle they shall receive another bill during the next billing cycle with the past due charges of 10% with current charges added together.
- 2. If the amount is not paid on or before the 15th day of the month, and they have a two month balance the customer will receive a water disconnect notice.
- 3. The water disconnect notice provides the customer with the amount they owe for sewer service and the date it must be paid to avoid having their water service disconnected.

## TOWN OF GREENVILLE ORDINANCE NO. 2013-WR-021

- 4. The customer at this point has the option to contact the Greenville Municipal Water and Sewer Utility, prior to the water service disconnect date, to make payment arrangements.
- 5. The two-month sewer usage balance along with the water service reconnect fee OF \$50.00 must be paid in full to re-establish water service.
- 6. The Greenville Municipal Water and Sewer Utility requires a minimum of 24 hours to re-instate water service, on the same business day if they receive the payment during regular business hours, and the personnel to do so.
- 7. If a customer requests water service to be re-instated after regular business hours, the decision shall be made by the Greenville Municipal Water and Sewer Utility Superintendent or Assistant Greenville Municipal Water and Sewer Utility Superintendent if Superintendent is not available. A charge of \$50.00 will be added to accommodate overtime hours it would take to re-instate service.
