Terry Boaz opened the meeting. All members, Charles Birkla, James Harl, John Cody, L.C. Asher, Chris Linton, Janice Gibson, and two visitors were present. The minutes from the last meeting were read and approved. Claims were presented and approved for payment. The treasurer's reports shows a checking fund total of \$12,811.22, (General Fund \$1,730.49, Local Road \$3,937.50, Street \$6,849.76, and CCIF \$293.47). The Revenue Sharing Fund has \$3,189.28.

Ralph Dodge wants a fire hydrant on his property moved so that it doesn't interfere with his driveway. The board agreed that the fire hydrant should and would be moved.

Charles Birkla is to see that rock and oil are placed on the alleys where it is needed.

James Harl reported there had been 17 drug related arrest in Greenville during the past month. He said he would like to have one or two non-paid deputies to ride with him while on patrol. The board stated that a part-time non-paid deputy or deputies must be recommended by the current marshall and then be accepted or rejected as deputy marshalls by action of the town board.

Wilodean Miller moved and Robert Gibson seconded that we annex the Robert Gibson property adjacent to the park. All voted in favor.

Robert Gibson moved and Wilodean Miller seconded that the Town of Greenville become a part of the Floyd County Sewer District. All voted in favor. This seems to be our best chance of obtaining funds for sewage treatment.


Chris Linton resigned as main helper for the water company to be effective when a suitable replacement can be found.

L.C. Asher reported 7 water hook-ups. He requested a water meter be installed at the site of the bulk sales. He also reported a large percentage of water metered at the master meter of the lake was not being metered as sold. The loss of water may be attributed to water leaks and or incorrect meter readings. He may start replacing old meter with new and have the old meters checked and repaired.

Wilodean Miller moved the meeting be closed.
