## MINUTES OF TOWN COUNCIL MEETING, July 14, 1998.

The regular monthly meeting of the Greenville Town Council was called to order by President Ted Miller @7:30 p.m.. Call of the roll - Council members Ray Gibson, Gerry Burkhart and Mike receveur present; also the Clerk Treasurer.

Also attending was Town attorney Jef Fifer, Utility Superintendent Gary Getrost, Janice Gibson, and Marshal David Moore.

Minutes of the June 9, 1998 meeting was approved on motion by Mike Receveur, seconded by Gerry Burkhart. (4-0)

President MIller called for a motion to consider Ordinance 1998-W-O1, titled "An Ordinance Providing For An Increase in Water Utility Rates". Mike Receveur motioned the Council consider Ordinance 1998-W-O1, seconded by Ray Gibson. On vote of the Council the motion carried 4-O. President Miller then called for a vote to approve Ordinance 1998-W-O1. After careful consideration the Council voted unanimously to approve the Ordinance. Miller then declared Ordinance 1998-W-O1 approved and adopted by the Council.(4-O)

President MIller was advised that property owners along the Bradford were questioning the Utility's position of denying water. Miller stated that until an agreement is signed by the developers water service will be denied. Should any of the affected owners want a copy of the letter (sent to Sherrell/Watts) they should be obliged since the letter is a public record. Attorney Jef Fifer stated the Council is, in his opinion, actions by the Council is proper; that should those owners question the Council's stand they can proceed through the Utility Consumer Council (IURC).

Marshal David Moore requested the Council approve the purchase of a new radio, since the radio now in use is beyond repair. Council advised him if the money is available issue a Purchase Order.

The Council took under advisement proposals for a utility truck submitted by Utility Superintendent Gary Getrost.

Council approved (4-0) claims for the Town/Utility.
