October 9, 1978 Town Hall

The regular monthly meeting of the Greenville Town Board was called to order by acting President Bill Voyles. All board members were present. Financial report for the month of September was presented to board members. Minutes of the previous meeting was read and approved.

Pearl Tush questioned Gary Getrost on the condition of the water and the water usage at Floyd Central; there being reason to believe a water leak occured around the Floyd Central School area. Mr. Getrost stated that a leak was detected at that location and that the school board was prepared to reimburse the utility for usage. Bob Isgrigg of our consulting firm stated that the foul taste in the water should be lessened with the cooler weather.

Mr. Frank Francis and Mr. Steven Cobb of Louisville were present to asked the board to annex the area owned by Mr. Francis for purpose of building a new plant. Mr. Cobb stated his company desires to build a laminating plant in this area. The plant will be clean and would not create any dust or wood sawdust. His firm would employee 20-22 employees eventually, with this labor to be trained by his company Cobb Wood Products.

Mr. Cobb stated his firm needed:

- 1. Available labor (men & women)-which is available in the Greenville area.
- Available land to build. (zoned industrial)
- 3. Water enough for sprinkler system. Since there are no Fire Hydrants in the area of the proposed plant site Mr. Cobb asked if the two (2) inch flush hydrants could be replaced with the standard fire hydrant. Mr. Isgrigg stated he could forsee no problem with the board agreeing. Mr. Cobb stated a regular line would be sufficient for general use of rest rooms and drinking.
- 4. Approved septic system approval of floyd County Health Dept. would be needed.
- 5. Power needed would be 220 V/3-phase service.
- 6. Taxes Mr. Cobb requested current appraisal be kept for a five (5) year period.

  He was informed that the Town of Greenville may have to add the town rate if he is able to obtain approval from the county for his request.
- Mr. Cobb was advised the town would proceed with his request.

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Bob Isgrigg presented the board with the Greenville Preliminary Engineering Report for upgrading the Greenville Water System. Mr. Isgrigg discussed with the board measures to be taken in obtaining a rate increase and to have sufficient water in the future.

Gary Getrost requested a salary review. Pearl Tush advised the board would review his salary and advise him at a later date.

The board discussed the problem of snow removal but took no action.

Bill Voyles moved for adjournment, seconded by Pearl Tush.
