The regular monthly meeting of the Greenville Town Board was opened by President Jack Sprigler. All board members were present, also in attendance were G. Getrost, J. Gibson and other interested persons.

Minutes of the previous meeting and the financial statements were presented to and approved by the board.

Mr Neeld expressed thanks for work done on the Pekin Road Waterline. Mr. Neeld stated that the tile had not been put in place in his daughter's driveway, if the driveway drains well without it there is no need to replace the tile. Mr. Neeld will inform the board concerning this matter.

Motion was made by H. Spears and seconded by V. Miller to repair the valve on the Water tank and fix the drain to take care of the water if the valve failed. Bob Isgrigg will start immediately on this matter and if necessary fix a temporary drain until an easement can be obtained. Ab Roehm was asked for an estimate of the damage to his Landscaping because of the water overflow.

V. Miller motioned to have the road behind Mill of Miller's property in Parkland Heights fixed to take care of the water runoff problem, H. Spears seconded.

Town Marshall requested a Kojack Light for his car. Motion was made by Jack Sprigler to purchase the light if Richardson's insurance allows, motion seconded by H. Spears.

G. Getrost was asked to present to the board a list of the tools stolen from him at the Water Plant.

Mr. Getrost informed us of the need for barricades. Mr. Spears seconded the motion made by Mr. Sprigler to purchase six barricades.

No other business brought before the board, motion for adjournment made by H. Spears seconded by J. Sprigler.

Water Purchase Contract  
Floyds Knobs - Ramsey Water

The attached Water Purchase Contract between Floyds Knobs as purchaser and Ramsey Water as seller is returned. The contract has been approved.

Mr. Rudy mentions in his transmittal that an amendment of the Ramsey-Greenville contract is being prepared. He states a problem with the elimination of a minimum purchase by Greenville. Mr. Martin of Ramsey finds the elimination of this provision objectionable. Mr. Rudy further states that Greenville would probably purchase three million gallons of water per month.

We suggest a minimum charge remain in the Greenville contract and the contract be immediately assigned to Floyds Knobs. Greenville will use more than one million gallons per month, so the minimum purchase is academic. However, Floyds Knobs will advantage of a minimum purchase. We assume the minimum purchase required for Floyds Knobs accommodates the one million gallon minimum purchase by Greenville.

Please furnish the computation of the \$.05 (5%) add on for water from Floyds Knobs to Greenville.
