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Minutes of Greenville Town Council Meeting December 14th, 2009

Council President Talbotte Richardson called the regular monthly meeting to order. Other Councilpersons present were Bob Wright, Patti Hayes, James Pearce and Randal Johnes, along with Clerk Jack Travillian. Also attending the meeting were Water Utility Superintendent Gary Getrost, town attorney Rick Fox, and other concerned citizens. Chaplain Mark Avery opened the meeting with a prayer, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes: Councilman Johnes made a motion and Councilwoman Hayes seconded to accept the November 9th monthly minutes as revised by Councilman Johnes. Motion passed 5-0. Motion was made by Councilman Johnes and seconded by Councilwoman Hayes to accept as written the minutes from special annexation meeting of November 24, 2009.

The council voted to approve 5-0.

Councilman Johnes read the following confirming Resolutions made in the November 9th, 2009 Monthly Meeting: Resolution 2009-R-077; CONFIRMING RESOLUTION CONCERNING CHESTER "BUTCH" RICHARDSON AS THE CITIZEN OF THE YEAR FOR THE TOWN OF GREENVILLE, INDIANA. Resolution 2009-R-078; RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE DECLARATION OF SALVAGE EQUIPMENT OF THE GREENVILLE MUNICIPAL WATER UTILITY OF GREENVILLE, INDIANA. Resolution 2009-R-079; RESOLUTION CONFIRMING ACCEPTANCE OF SNOW AND ICE REMOVAL BIDS FOR SNOW AND ICE REMOVAL FOR THE TOWN OF GREENVILLE, INDIANA FOR 2009-2010.Resolution 2009-R-080; RESOLUTION DOCUMENTING THE CASHING OUT OF CD 80409 OWNED BY GREENVILLE MUNICIPAL WATER UTILITY OF GREENVILLE, INDIANA.

President Richardson offered condolence to Marshal Moore from the entire council about the passing of his son Kevin last month. Everyone was saddened and shock by the sudden loss. Marshal Moore thanked the council for attending services and wanted them to know just how much it meant having the entire council's support during this trying time.

Marshal's Report:

Marshal Moore thanked the other police officers for filling in this month. The department has four (4) active cases and closed one (1) during the previous thirty days. The department continues to have an increase in backup calls for the Floyd County Sheriff's Department. This may be due to the timing of their patrols during high traffic hours for each department.

The start of the New Year is time for each officer to compete the mandatory twenty-four (24) hour annual training. These hours should be completed at the officer's discretion.

Financial:

Review/Approval Checks and Expenditures: Clerk Travillian presented the forms for the checks written from the utility and the town.

Water Business:

Superintendent Getrost submitted monthly adjustments to the council. The board approved the adjustments for the bills (5-0).

Pumping station in Galena: Superintendent Getrost reported that the ground has been broken for the pumping station in Galena. Getrost presented the council with an estimate for installation of Minutes 12.14.09

the new pump from Dan Cristiani Excavating. The estimate included \$10,000 for removal of the pump at present location, \$25,000 for installation of the pump, and \$23,500 for installation of 12" and 8" mains. The council went over the rules for declaring an emergency for receiving bids on the project. The question was raised about getting a project design from an engineering firm. Councilman Johnes suggested getting Primavera Engineering in Corydon to do the project.

Councilman Johnes notified the council that there is a possibility of receiving a grant to construct two (2) new 500,000 water towers in Greenville and Galena. He has been in contact with State Representative Ed Clere and was instructed to contact Paul Robertson who represents the town's district. Councilman Johnes will be meeting on January 8, 2010 with Rep. Robertson and the Director of River Hills Development.

Floyds Knobs Water Utility has passed an increase of 21 cents per 1,000 gallons along to the Greenville Water Utility. The rate increase has taken effect.

Service Charges Ordinance: Councilman Johnes is working with Town Attorney Fox and Superintendent Getrost to develop a Rate Increase Ordinance for multiple service runs.

Superintendent Getrost has requested that the council remind all water utility employees the importance to track the amount of hours spent on Town business for reimbursement from town budget. Councilman Johnes has developed a time sheet to be used by the Water Utility Employees. These time sheets are to be submitted once a month to the Greenville Town Clerk for reimbursement to the Greenville Water Utility.

The council held Executive Session meeting for the annual review of Water Utility Employees Performance Reviews. At the Executive Session recommendation were given for salary increases. The council voted 5-0 to accept those figures. Deputy Water Clerk Crystal Burkhart was given \$2 per hour raising her rate to \$10 per hour. Assistance Superintendant Steven Schmidt was given \$.75 per hour raising his rate to \$16.65 per hour. Water Clerk Amy Stone was given \$.58 per hour to a rate of \$17.20 per hour. All merit increases to be reflective on their first pay period in January 2010.

Resolution 2009-R-082 ORDINANCE RESOLUTION CONTRACT AGREEMENT BETWEEN GREENVILLE MUNICIPAL WATER UTILITY SUPERINTENDENT GARY GETROST AND THE GREENVILLE MUNICIPAL WATER UTILITY COUNCIL OF GREENVILLE, INDIANA CONCERNING EMPLOYEE COMPENSATION VARIANCE: Ordinance was read and discussed. Motion was made by Councilman Johnes and seconded by Council President Richardson to accept the ordinance as read. Ordinance passed 5-0.

Superintendent Getrost requested a hydraulic system study be conducted for all Greenville Water Utility lines. The recommendation was to contact Jacobi, Tombs and Lance engineering firm.

Election of Council President for 2010; Councilman Randal Johnes nominated Talbotte Richardson for President. Councilman Bob Wright seconded the nomination. Nominations were closed. Council voted 5-0.

Committee Chairpersons for 2010 as appointed by President Elect Richardson.

Patti Hayes – Public Relations; Jim Pearce - Property Cleanup; Bob Wright – Emergency Services; Randal Johnes – Special Projects and Vice President; Talbotte Richardson – Streets & Roads.

Committee Reports:

Streets and Roads: President Richardson requested that a survey be prepared for all of Clark Street and Cross Street from Clark Street to school property. Motion was made by Councilman Johnes and seconded by Councilwoman Hayes. Motion passed 5-0.

Councilman Wright/Emergency Services:

Councilman Wright requested a used light bar be purchased and installed on the 1996 Jeep patrol vehicle. Safety issues were the main concern. Motion was made by Councilman Johnes and Seconded by President Richardson for the purchase, using funds from the Rainy Day Fund. Motion passed 5-0.

Councilman Johnes requested that Clerk Travillian check into lowering the cost for life insurance for Greenville Water Utility personnel by getting a bid for combining all policies.

Contractor Ron Jenkins appeared before the council requesting a variance to build a storage facility for property located on Highway 150 at Jack Sprigler Drive. The council heard the request but wanted to table the request for more discussion requested by Councilman Pearce. Mr. Jenkins insisted that a yea or nay vote be taken. Council President Richardson made a motion to deny the request for variance. Councilman Johnes seconded the motion. Council voted 3-0 to deny variance. Voting to deny was Council President Richardson, Councilwoman Hayes and Councilman Johnes. Councilman Pearce and Councilman Wright did not cast a vote {abstained}.

No further business coming before the Council the meeting was adjourned.
