A Resolution for Disposal of Surplus Property

WHEREAS, the Greenville Town Council is the entitle responsible for the sale and/or disposition of property belonging to the Town;

WHEREAS, Indiana Code 5-22-22-3 allows for the sale of property belonging to a governmental body, which is no longer needed or is unfit for the purpose for which it is intended;

WHEREAS, Indiana Code 5-22-22-6 allows for the sale of property belonging to a governmental body, by public or private sale or transfer without advertising;


WHEREAS, the Greenville Town Council desires to transfer bulletproof vests which are no longer needed or are now unfit for the purpose for which it was intended,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Greenville Town Council,


